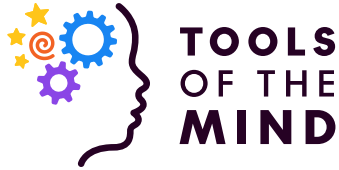

Super Kids Playschool offers a unique and exciting approach to preschool education. Our curriculum incorporates and inspired by the following programs to provide a holistic education: FLIGHT, Tools of the Mind, Preschool Acrobatic Arts, Gymnastics for All, and Process Art. Children are provided with a valuable head start to education, a healthy lifestyle and an exciting curriculum exclusive to Super Kids Playschool!

Our preschool program reflects the importance of play and movement in a child's healthy development. Through intentional teaching practices, our play-based programs offer children opportunities to expand their skills and knowledge in a fun and safe environment. Our child-centred practices respond to children's interests and foster in-depth studies, by listening well and asking open ended questions. These practices offer different ways for children to learn and a variety of opportunities for children to show what they know. We foster strong relationships with families. Activities and lessons focus on the whole child and cover physical, intellectual, social and emotional development. This co-education program will help build foundational educational and physical skills.

While we generally follow the EPSB calendar throughout the school year, we have adapted PD days to allow for optimal Professional Development for our teachers. Please reference the calendar in Brightwheel. First day of school is one week after EPSB first day of school and last day in June is one week before EPSB last day.

REGISTRATION

Admission is accepted on a "first come, first served" basis. For the school year, registration fee, completed registration forms, and payment of first month's tuition is required to reserve each child's place in the playschool. During the school year we accept registrations for the current year as enrolment allows.

WAITLIST POLICY

A waitlist is maintained, and the order is strictly adhered to. The Director will contact you by email if a spot becomes available. You will be given a 48-hour window to provide a response. After 48 hours, the Director will contact the next in line if no response is received. It is your responsibility to check your emails. The Director is not responsible for holding a spot if emails bounce back.

COST BREAKDOWN

Initial Fees:

Registration Fee - \$75 - non-refundable fee due at Registration

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of one full month fees (prior to Affordability Grant) is required to be paid at Registration. This deposit will be applied to June 2027 fees. Affordability Grant credits for deposit will be credited to accounts April 1, 2027.

First Month's tuition: Full September 2026 tuition fees are due one-month prior to the start of the school year (August 9, 2026). October - May monthly tuition fees will be withdrawn on the 1st of every month.

Monthly Tuition:

Part-Time 2 days T/TH \$265, (\$165 after Affordability Grant)

Part-Time 3 days M/W/F \$345 (\$245 after Affordability Grant)

Full-Time 5 days per week (am or pm) \$595 (\$495 after Affordability Grant)

All fees shall be paid through Brightwheel. Enrolment in AutoPay is required. \$25 administrative fee will be assessed to NSF or late fees. If paying via credit card, a convenience fee of 2.95% is added.



HEALTH POLICY

Please notify the school through Brightwheel if your child will be absent. Children may not attend school if they have the following symptoms:

1. Thick or discoloured discharge/drainage from the nose
2. Persistent cough or sneezing
3. Fever
4. Sore throat
5. Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea within the previous 48 hours
6. Headache
7. Earache (this disrupts equilibrium and balance)
8. New or unexplained rash
9. Discharge from the eye(s)/pink eye
10. Requiring greater care and attention than can be provided without compromising the care of the other children in the program.

If a child develops signs of illness during class time, parents will be notified and will need to pick up their child right away. In cases where parents are unavailable, emergency contacts will be notified. After illness, children may return to school if they have been symptom free for at least 48 hours. If a child has been prescribed antibiotics, they may return to school 24 hours after the first dose has been given. A doctor's note may be required prior to the child's return to school.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Withdrawal Notice must be received in writing at least one month prior to the withdrawal date (e.g. March 1st for April 1st withdrawal date). A withdrawal date after April 30 will result in a forfeit of the initial deposit.

There are no refunds or pro-rating for partial month attendance.

A child who is away from the program for a period of time and will be returning later in the year must pay full monthly fees in the interim.

LATE PICKUP FEES

Parents are required to pick up their children at the end of class (12pm for morning classes, 3:45pm for afternoon classes). If children are repeatedly picked up late, (more than 3 occurrences) a late fee of \$1 per minute per child will be assessed for the time the child remains in our care. If you anticipate being late picking up your child please message the teachers. Late pick-up fees are added to the account and must be cleared by the next time tuition is due or late fees are applicable for the account holding a balance.



SNACKS

Each child is required to bring their own small, nutritious snack from home. Please be sure that all snacks are nut free. We ask that children bring only a small snack (maximum 2 or 3 items) that they can open themselves and eat in 10-15 minutes. Please pack water bottles, and no juice or juice boxes.



DRESS

Children should be dressed appropriately in comfortable, durable and washable clothing. Please avoid zippers, velcro and buttons, and if a dress is worn, be sure to add a pair of shorts or leggings underneath. Please note that playschool can be messy, and learning through exploring may result in some accidents. Smocks will be provided but an extra set of clothing should be packed in backpacks in case of messes or accidents.

For gymnastics time, please note that for safety, children will be barefoot. If a child has a wart, grippy socks will be allowed, and/or the wart can be covered with liquid bandage spray.



CLOSURES

Super Kids Playschool reserves the right to cancel school up to two (2) days per season due to inclement weather, illness, facility issues, or other unforeseen circumstances without offering makeup classes or monetary compensation. Families will be notified of cancellations as early as possible via Brightwheel message. Cancellations beyond two days per season will be handled on a case-by-case basis.




PARENT INVOLVEMENT

We believe that being intentional in building positive, strong relationships with parents and children gives us the opportunity for growth. Strong relationships with families can help us get to know children within their family cultures and by working together with families, we can better support each child. Families can share important information about their child's experiences, development, accomplishments and interests with the school. We will be communicating special moments throughout our days to families through our portal. Newsletters are sent out monthly. While you won't be physically in the classroom, we will strive to include you in your child's experience with us. We will also have special class days in which families are welcomed in to participate in their child's classroom. Please refer to the calendar in Brightwheel files.
